Ivor Searle adds Volkswagen Crafter TDI engines to remanufactured range

Expanding its all-makes programme to include 2.0-litre Euro 6 units for second-generation Crafter vans with savings of up to 40% compared to original equipment

Ivor Searle has expanded its portfolio of remanufactured products with the addition of diesel engines for second-generation Volkswagen Crafter vans. The new 2.0-litre TDI applications cover Euro 6 four-cylinder units for vehicles manufactured from 2017 onwards.

The range includes power outputs from 102bhp to 177bhp and supports front, rear, and all-wheel drive configurations. These units are compatible with both six-speed manual and eight-speed automatic transmissions. According to Ivor Searle, these remanufactured engines cost up to 40% less than original equipment (OE) alternatives.

The company's all-makes programme, which includes engines, gearboxes, and turbochargers, currently covers over 90% of the UK vehicle parc. All units are supplied with a 12-month unlimited mileage parts and labour warranty. For stock items ordered before 3:30pm, the remanufacturer provides free next-day delivery to the UK mainland.
