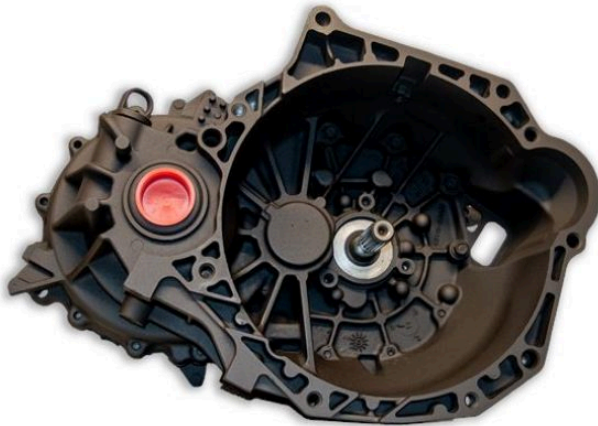

Ivor Searle has announced the addition of remanufactured manual transmissions for the Hyundai Tucson and Kia Sportage to its product portfolio. The new six-speed gearbox covers 1.6-litre petrol variants of these SUVs built from 2015 to 2021.

The company continues to expand its “all makes” programme, which includes engines, gearboxes, and turbos, providing coverage for over 90% of the UK’s passenger car and light commercial vehicle (LCV) parc. To assist with vehicle uptime, the remanufacturer maintains stocks to support its distribution network.

For customer protection, all Ivor Searle gearboxes are provided with a 12-month unlimited mileage parts and labour warranty. The company also offers a logistical service featuring free next-day delivery across the UK mainland for stock items ordered before 15:30.
