This new unit is applicable to 26 different models across Ford, Peugeot, Citroën, and Vauxhall, covering over 90% of the UK's vehicle parc. The four-cylinder engine delivers power outputs ranging from 75 to 120PS and is compatible with a selection of Ford and Stellantis vehicles manufactured from 2017 onwards. These include Ford Focus, EcoSport, Puma, Kuga, Transit Connect, and Transit Courier models, as well as Peugeot 208, 308, 508, 2008, 3008, 5008 SUVs, Partner, Rifter, Expert, and Traveller vans. For Citroën, the engine covers C3, C4, and C5 applications, along with Berlingo, Dispatch, and Space Tourer LCVs. In the Vauxhall range, the unit fits the Corsa supermini and Grandland SUV, as well as Combo and Vivaro van models.

Ivor Searle engines are remanufactured to exceed the BS AU257:2002 Code of Practice for remanufacturing engines and are priced up to 40% less than original equipment alternatives. All Ivor Searle engines are supplied with a 12-month unlimited mileage parts and labour warranty.
